

Show Policies of the
American Eskimo Dog Club of New England
hereafter referred to as "AEDCONE."

EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY
These policies may be changed/updated at
the discretion of AEDCONE.

1. PRE-ENTRY POLICY

In accordance with "**Chapter 4, Section 3. Pre-Entry** found in *UKC Rules for Dog Events Misconduct & Discipline Guidelines for Dog Events Rulebook*:

"Clubs accepting pre-entries must establish a pre-entry deadline after which no further pre-entries will be accepted. The pre-entry deadline must be published with the premium list/club announcement of the event and in any other event information on the UKC website. Clubs may offer a discounted entry fee for pre-entries. For clubs offering day-of-show/trial entries, **exhibitors whose entries fail to arrive by the pre-entry deadline date must be treated as a day-of-show/trial entry. Entries received after the pre-entry deadline date will be charged the day-of-show entry fee.** Clubs may elect to have a Pre-Entry Only event. In such a case no day-of-show/trial entries can be accepted at the event and any entry received after the pre-entry deadline date and time must be returned in its entirety. Clubs must indicate that the event will be pre-entry only on the Event Application. These events will be designated "PRE-ENTRY ONLY" at the top of their listing in any official announcement/premium list and on the UKC website. This information must also be included in any other club announcement of the event. ***Pre-entries are to be submitted directly to the club's Event Secretary or the club's designated Event Manager. Third party entry services must have the written permission of the host club in order to take entries for any events offered by a UKC licensed club. All third party entry services that list UKC licensed events must state clearly on any website or publication that the service operates independently from the host club and the UKC. All UKC licensed clubs have the right to refuse entries from any third party entry services.***

"DEFINITIONS

Third Party Entry Service - A third party entry service is any individual, group or association that allows an exhibitor to submit an entry for a UKC licensed event and does not have direct connection with the UKC, UKC licensed host club, or designated UKC Event Manager."

2. SHOW CHAIRPERSON(S) POLICY

The Board of Directors of AEDCONE have met and voted to allow the Show Chairperson(s) to enter and exhibit their dogs at its shows.

3. MOVE UP POLICY

Move-ups must be submitted immediately after the completion of the specific breed's group.

4. SUBSTITUTION POLICY

Rally Obedience and/or Obedience Events: Substitution of a dog(s) will be permitted up to the close of Day of Show Entries for the SAME Performance Event ONLY.

Conformation Events: Substitution of dog(s) will NOT be permitted under any circumstance for Conformation Events.

5. REFUND POLICY

Entries will NOT be refunded in the event the dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian, Judge, or asked to leave by a member of the Show Committee. There will be NO day of show refunds. A **Pre-entry** refund will be permitted up to the close of Pre-Entries under the following circumstances:

Conformation Events: If a dog becomes ill, a note from your vet is required for a refund. *There will be NO refund for females in season.*

Rally Obedience and/or Obedience Events: *Females in Season*. No female in season may participate in a Rally Obedience and/or Obedience Trial, as per UKC Rules governing Rally Obedience and Obedience Events. Should a female come into season AFTER the close of Pre-Entry date, then AEDCONE will retain 50% of the entry fee as a processing fee of any trial competitor who provides a veterinarian's certificate verifying that the female came into season after the closing date for entries. The certificate may be mailed, provided the postmark is no later than the date prior to the day of the trial, or delivered by hand to the Event Secretary/Manager before the published start time of the trial, as outlined in VIII. D. 4. of the Official UKC Rally Obedience Rulebook; and XVIII. I. 1. of the Official UKC Obedience Rulebook.

If an event is canceled due to unforeseen circumstances or disease outbreak pre-entry fees will be returned to the exhibitor. No refunds will be issued for exhibitors who do not attend and have already paid. Day of show entries will not be refunded under any circumstances

Please note, these are the solely the policies of AEDCONE and not of any other event offering body holding events in conjunction with AEDCONE.
